### **Operating Environment**

Warning

# **Operating Environment**

Caution

### **Installation / Moving**

### **Basic Operation**

- **STEP 1.** Plug the power cord into the power receptacle.
- **STEP 2.** Turn on the Power Switch.
- STEP 3. Select the Currency Currency
- STEP 4. Select a Counting Mode.
- **STEP 5.** Adjust Hopper guide to the notes to be counted.
- **STEP 6**. Put the notes onto the Hopper, and counting starts automatically.
